



Silver Bear Administration

To Earn The Silver Bear for your nametag:

1. Complete while on course the Personal Vision Worksheet. This must be completed to the satisfaction of your Patrol Counselor and counter signed by one of the Assistant Scoutmasters. To be counted as completed on course it must be copied for the Silver Bear records by the course registrar.
2. Once returned to your home unit the scout must be registered as a Boy Scout, Venture or Varsity scout for a minimum of 6 months during which time they will serve in a position of unit leadership (as defined by the Boy Scout Eagle Rank requirements).
3. At the end of the 6 months the scout will complete a Scoutmaster Conference (home unit Scoutmaster). At this conference the scout will need to have completed or have made substantial progress (long term plans) with regard to 4 of the 5 personal plans in their Personal Vision Worksheet.
4. The requirements for the Silver Bear must be completed by the 18th birthday (for participants younger than 17.5 years at time of course). For participants older than 17.5 years at time of course, Course Director / Scout & Scoutmaster will agree to individual policy.
5. For adult leaders serving on the Silver Bear Course the administration of the Silver Bear is different (& according to the adult Silver Bear rules).

Once certified by the home unit Scoutmaster the scout or the Scoutmaster need to contact the 2005 Course Director / Scoutmaster to arrange for the Silver Bear Presentation at an appropriate time (usually unit Court of Honor).
